**How to be involved:** The interviews and auditions take place at Dancin! Performing Arts Center .

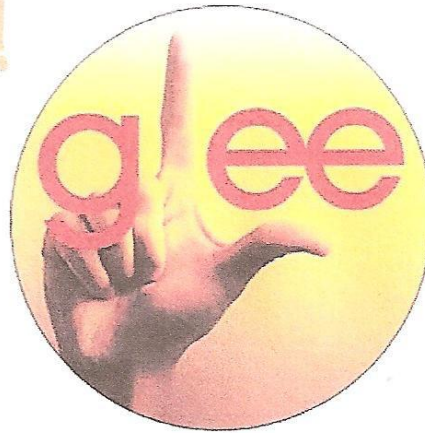

Julia was also one of the lucky few to dance in the London Brit Awards with the British group "Simply Red". Throughout her singing experiences, she performed on the "Costa Cruise Lines" and "Thompson Celebrations" Cruise Ships, many Pantomimes and worked alongside many great talents including the "Osmond Brothers."

Julia is well known for her roles as a featured performer in "Spirit of Broadway", "Dancing Queen," "One World," "Spirit of Christmas," "Twist & Shout," "The Rackpack," and "Shake Rattle & Roll" which many of you may have seen at the Eldorado Theater in Reno, Nevada where she became lead vocalist, Dance Captain and Company Manager for many years.
